Safety Tips

Foreign materials put in ventilators may increase internal temperature of the product, causing noise or fire.



Be careful not to damage power cords.

Strongly bending power cords and putting heavy objects on power cords may cause malfunction or damage. Moreover, pay special attention for children or pets not to damage power cords.



For product disassembly, make sure to stop the system and disconnect cords first.

Product disassembly or upgrade when power is ON may cause product damage or electric shock.



Do not keep medicines, glasses full of water and containers near the product.

Inserting water into the computer may cause product damage, electric shock or fire.

Safety Tips



Do not install the PC in high humid places such as bathrooms. Installation in high humid places may cause malfunction or electric shock. Make sure to use the PC in appropriate temperature/humid

(5°C~35°C/30%~80%).



Safely and appropriately dispose of moisture proof papers or plastic bags.

Children who eat moisture proof papers or put plastic bags on their heads may be get choked.



Do not place any disturbance within 15cm around the PC.

Internal temperature of the product may increase and cause a fire.



Do not install or use for long hours in sloping or high-vibration areas.

It may cause malfunction or product damage.



Plug into multi-outlets and outlets with grounding terminal.

Non-grounded outlets may cause electric shock or product breakdown.



Do not touch power cords with wet hands.

It may cause electric shock.




Do not put heavy objects on the product.


• Top Cover & Bracket Disassembly



- Disassemble the hand screw and detach the top cover as shown in Step1. / Step2.
- Disassemble the screw in Step3 and detach each bracket.

Motherboard & ATX Power Assembly




- Assemble the motherboard as shown in Step1.


Cable Connection




- · Connect each cable as shown in the figure.
- · Pay special attention to connection direction in connecting cables because there may be damages in parts.










****** Recommendation for HDD Drive Installation




For ④, SATA cable and HDD drive cause interference. Use "¬" shaped SATA cable for connection. **Caution**: It may be impossible to install HDD in ③ & ④ due to interference of other cables.

Note.


- * For Plastic ODD Bezel disassembly, refer to P17.
- * When it is difficult to detach the Plastic ODD Bezel, contact the ODD manufacturer instead of putting strong force.
- As shown in Step1 → Step2, assemble the top cover and fix it using hand screw.
- Step3. After installing a computer and connecting to power, press the ODD button to pull out ODD tray.
 Remove the tape attached to the rear panel of aluminum ODD bezel and perform assembly carefully.

Multi-Card Reader

Using memory card

Multi-card reader is a mobile storage device which consists of a total of four slots. Various memory cards are available. Since each slot is marked with available card type, make sure to check card type before inserting a card.


- Users must purchase memory cards additionally depending on necessary capacity.
- Memory Stick Duo, Mini SD, RS-MMC, Micro SD(T-Flash) and MMC Micro cards are so small to be directly inserted into multi-slots. Therefore, attach them to their dedicated adapters and then insert the dedicated adapters into multi-card slots.
